Ellen Murphy Meehan is a health care consultant. She is the central force in the Massachusetts Alliance of Safety Net Hospitals with whom she has worked for more than five years. She also worked for ten years as a Vice President at Lawrence General Hospital in Lawrence, Massachusetts. Mrs. Meehan earned her Master of Business Administration from the Darden Graduate School of Business at the University of Virginia, and her Bachelor of Arts degree from Simmons College.

Previously, Ellen Murphy Meehan had served on the board of directors of the Merrimack Valley Chamber of Commerce for 12 years and was its Vice President for Government Affairs for five years. She also was the leading force in Lawrence Into Action, a group of businesses located in the gateway to the City who were committed to removing blight and improving transportation, access and retail opportunities.

Mrs. Meehan and her husband, a seven-term, former Congressman, Marty Meehan now Chancellor at University of Massachusetts Lowell have two school-aged boys.
